**Norms for Indulgences at the commemoration of all Souls.**

1. From twelve o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within this week preceding or the week following 1<sup>st</sup> November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1<sup>st</sup> November to the 8<sup>th</sup> November.
2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.

**Month of the Holy Souls**: In November we remember and pray for the faithful departed in a special way. In our churches a number of masses will be offered for the deceased members of our families. It would be appreciated if you would bring in the list of those you wish to be prayed for with donation for next week end (envelope in your offertory Box). These envelopes may be put into the weekly Offertory Baskets or left in special box close to altar before each mass.
