### **Aughnasheelin community First Responder CPR & AED Group.**

The above group has been existence since 2008, our role is to provide a voluntary response to an emergency within the community or where needed in the event of someone collapsing suddenly, and requiring basic Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and follow up with use of Automated External Defibrillation which are available at the Community Centre and football pitch. The group consists of 19 persons spread throughout the community and they attend revalidation training at 4 monthly intervals to ensure they maintain their skills. It is the group's responsibility to ensure the AED's are kept in good working order. We plan an information evening in the **Community Centre on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March at 8:30pm Speaker is Helen & John Martin (a survivor of first responder CPR).**

The purpose is to highlight our availability & role in the community. We will supply an updated list of first responders with their mobile numbers.
