HOSPITALITY COURSE 2018

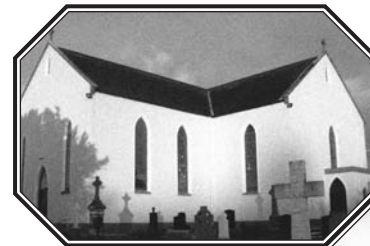

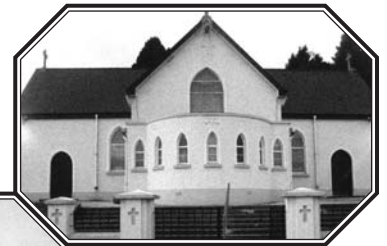
