Gospel Reflection

(Matthew: 5:38-48)

Jesus understands that no-one likes to be hurt and it's easy to want to punish others if they do hurt you. But Jesus says that if that is all we do then we will not make the world better.

Jesus is asking us to be brave and to try a new way of living. To stand up against what is wrong with love and kindness. Even if people have been upset with each other in the past they can make it up by talking about it and making things better.

God loves and cares for all of us and wants us to love all the other members of our global family – God created the world for the whole of our global family to live on.

But we haven't always been kind to the world. Some parts of the world suffer from unusual changes in the weather, where there have been floods or droughts that have damaged crops and homes, and put people's lives at risk.
