SafeTalk

SafeTalk is a half day FREE training programme that prepares participants to identify persons with thoughts of suicide and connect them to suicide first aid resources. These specific skills are called suicide alertness and are taught with the expectation that the person learning them will use them to help reduce suicide risk in their communities.

The training is suitable for everyone over 18 who wants to help prevent suicide and is prepared to become suicide alert.

A.S.I.S.T

(Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training)

ASIST is a training course developed for both members of the public and professionals and people whose work brings them into contact with people who may be vulnerable or at risk of suicide. This course is suitable for a broad range of people including care assistants, nurses, teachers, youth workers, home helps, childcare workers, public health nurses, the clergy, Gardaí, community volunteers.... This training enhances people's skills to intervene until the immediate risk of suicide is reduced or additional support can be found.
